

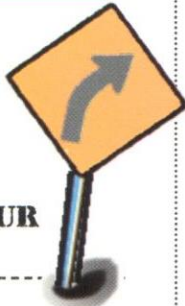

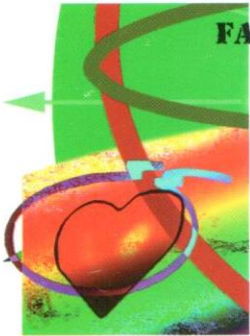


YOUR NAME IS
